- Call to Order
  - Meeting was called to order by Dan and Sarah
- Roll Call

- General Updates

- Committee Reports
  - Community Service
    - Big Brother/Big Sister (Michelle)
      - The first Red Key sponsored event with Big Brother/Big Sister will take place on March 1. Event will include pizza dinner with approximately 40 young people and the members of Red Key (dinner to be paid for a \$40 gift given to Red Key). After dinner, Red Key will join the young people in cheering on the Men's Basketball team as they take on Harvard at 7pm. Event is mandatory for all Red Key members.
      - In the future, smaller numbers of Big Brother/Big Sister pairs will be accompanied by a few Red Key members at various Cornell Athletic competitions and other events.
      - Television ads for Big Brother/Big Sister will take place, pending approval from Amy Foster and NCAA compliance. More information to follow.
    - Relay for Life (Dan)
      - Red Key voted to participate in the 2008 Relay for Life benefiting the American Cancer Society. Dana volunteered to be in-charge of the event. The dates are March 29-30. All members will be required to participate with a minimum amount of time to be determined. More information to follow.
  - Cornell Cup (Sarah)
    - Red Key has decided to finalize all plans for the Cornell Cup and to re-establish it for the 2008 Fall Semester.
    - As a preview, Red Key will organize a competition between Cornell's respective teams. Mike has agreed to be in-charge of this

- event. Plans will be discussed with Amy Foster in order to access any issues related to NCAA compliance for potential prizes.
    - Website (Mike)
      - Mike expressed concern with the time it takes for the website to update. He will discuss the problem with Chris Wlosinski in an attempt to come up with a solution.
  - Old Business
    - Toys for Tots Recap (Sarah)
